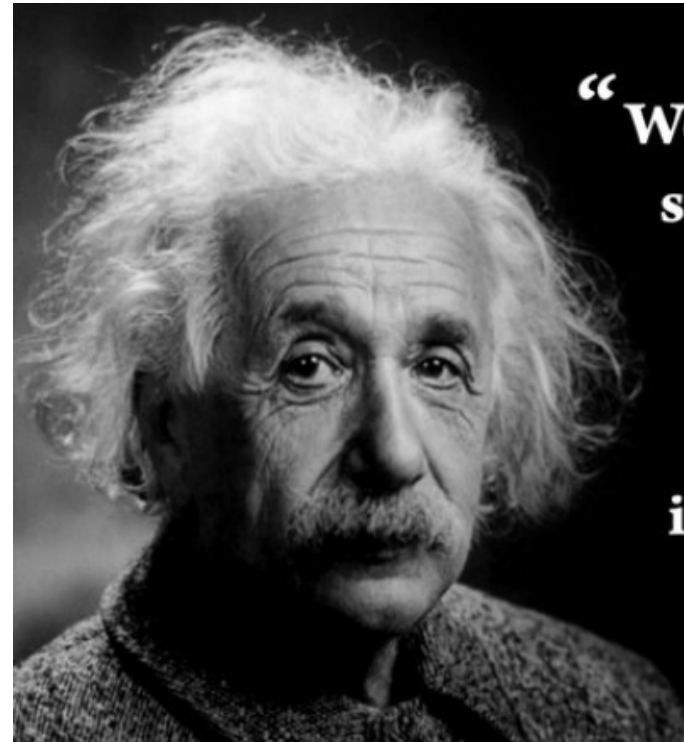

241 km/h (150 mph), a range of 161 km (100 miles)

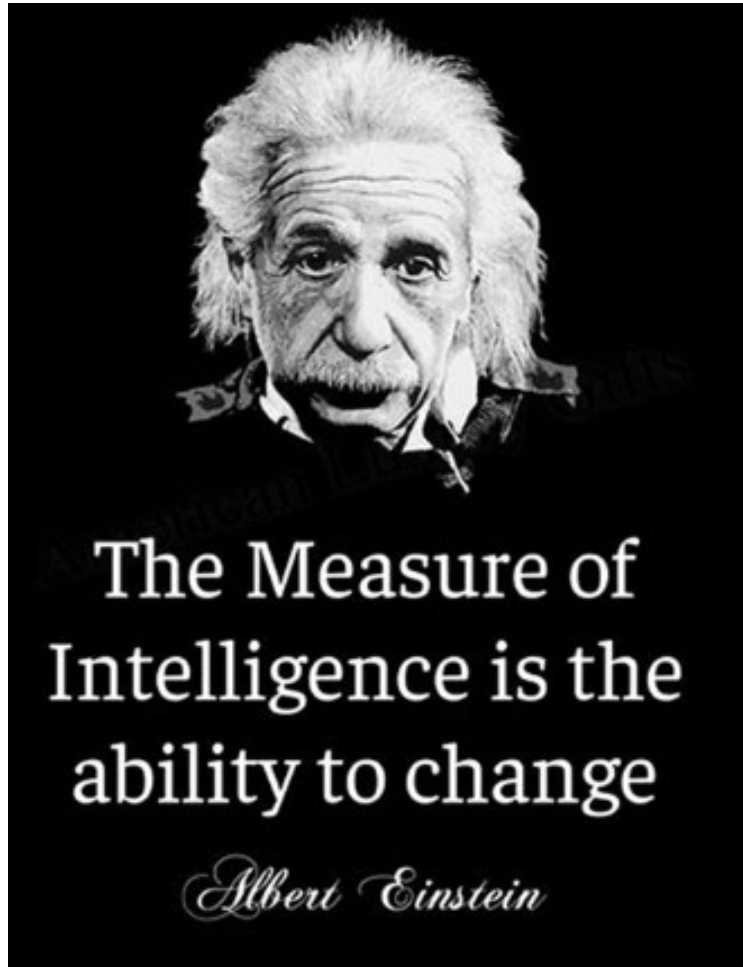
